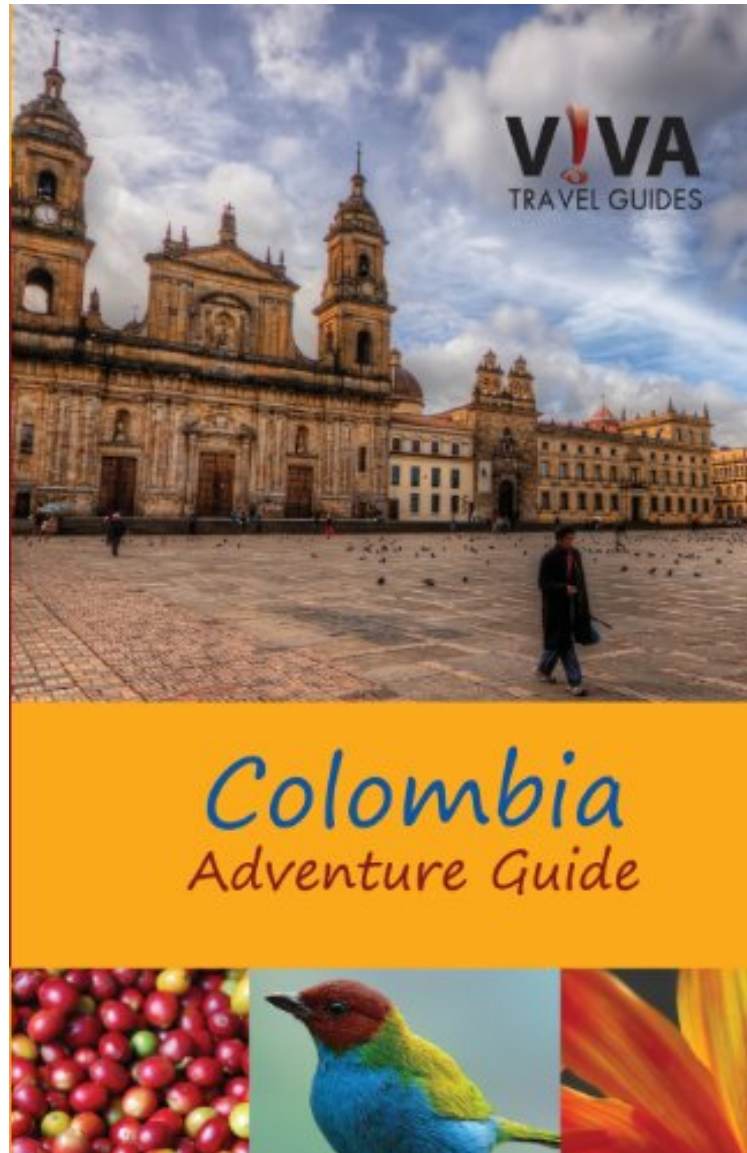

about 7 years and was disappointed to find this book has many inaccuracies and much outdated information as does every single guidebook I have seen about Colombia. Here's some quick examples:- The Medelln section of the Colombia guide has Museo de la Polica Nacional listed in Medellin, but if you look at their website link found in book - it is actually located in Bogot at Calle 9 No. 9 - 27.- I am surprised that the book didn't include Parque Arv in the list of things to do in Medelln, it's one of the most popular places, especially on weekends, at least most other guidebooks include this.- The admission fee for Parque Explora in Medelln, which is currently 18,000 pesos (\$9.49 USD at current exchange rate) that can be found on their website. The \$15 listed in book is wrong and the book should probably include prices in pesos with the fluctuating currency exchange rate.- Discoteca Mango's in Medelln listed in the book closed its doors in March 2012. The new Mango's that has since reopened in the same location in Itagui is nothing like the former club and is now more of a bar/cafe and no longer has stages with dancers performing like the old Mango's.- Missing many of the best restaurants in Medelln like Carmen, In Situ and Mu.Come on publisher, do some simple fact checks on the Internet. The only positive I would have to say about this book is that it is longer than Lonely Planet's pathetic Colombia guidebook so it does have somewhat better lodging listings and a bit better coverage of some of the cities.1 of 2 people found the following review helpful.
