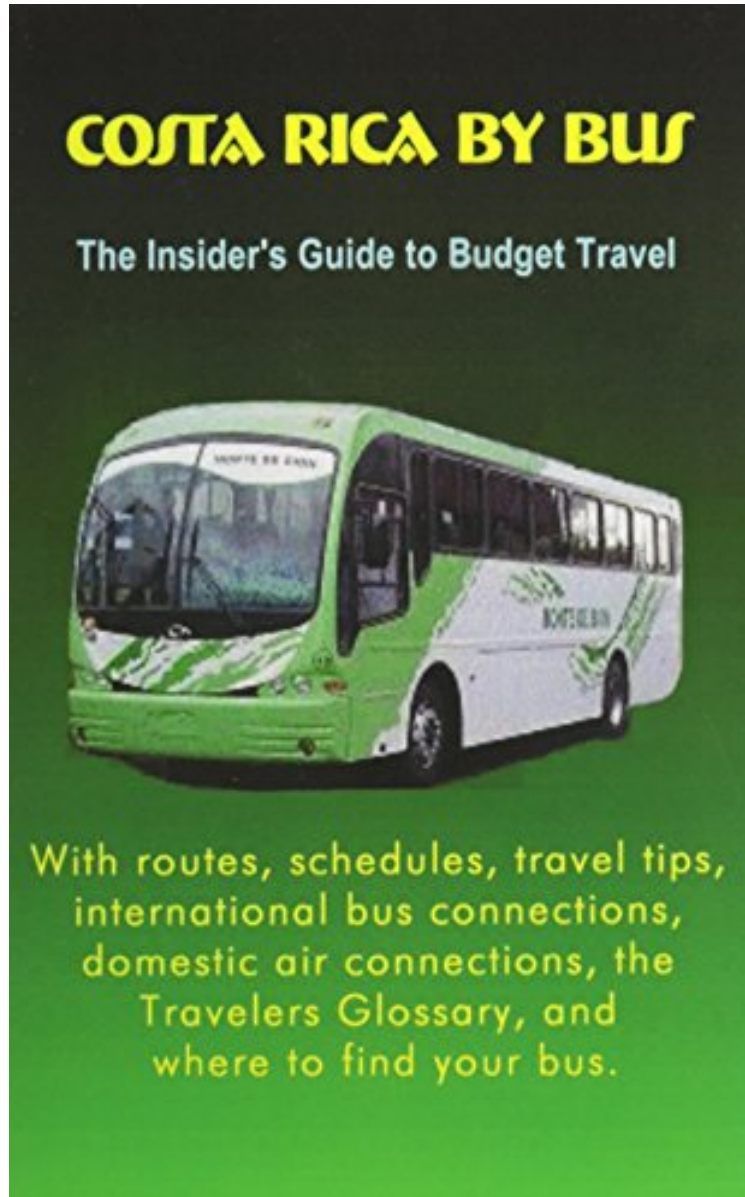

Some towns have multiple bus stops and not all have signage. There may be a full on bus depot in the center of town and another is just a spot along the road in front

of some store (in the same town) and another in a separate depot. Ask questions and look for lines of people waiting for something and then ask one of them. The good thing is that most all Ticos are very friendly. Don't take large bags on a bus, even a large backpack is problematic.
