This comprehensive wall map shows the country in its entirety, including many islands, bordering areas in Panama and Nicaragua, and its stunning Pacific Ocean and Caribbean Sea coastlines. Beautiful shaded relief and vibrant colors depict both topographic and bathymetric features such as mountain ranges, volcanoes, wetlands and coral reefs. Major infrastructure networks, including roads, highways, airports and ferry routes are also clearly labeled. User-friendly indexes list selected towns along with the country's abundant protected areas, such as National Wildlife Refuges and Parks, wetlands and nature reserves. The map is encapsulated in heavy-duty 1.6 mil laminate which makes the paper much more durable and resistant to the swelling and shrinking caused by changes in humidity.
