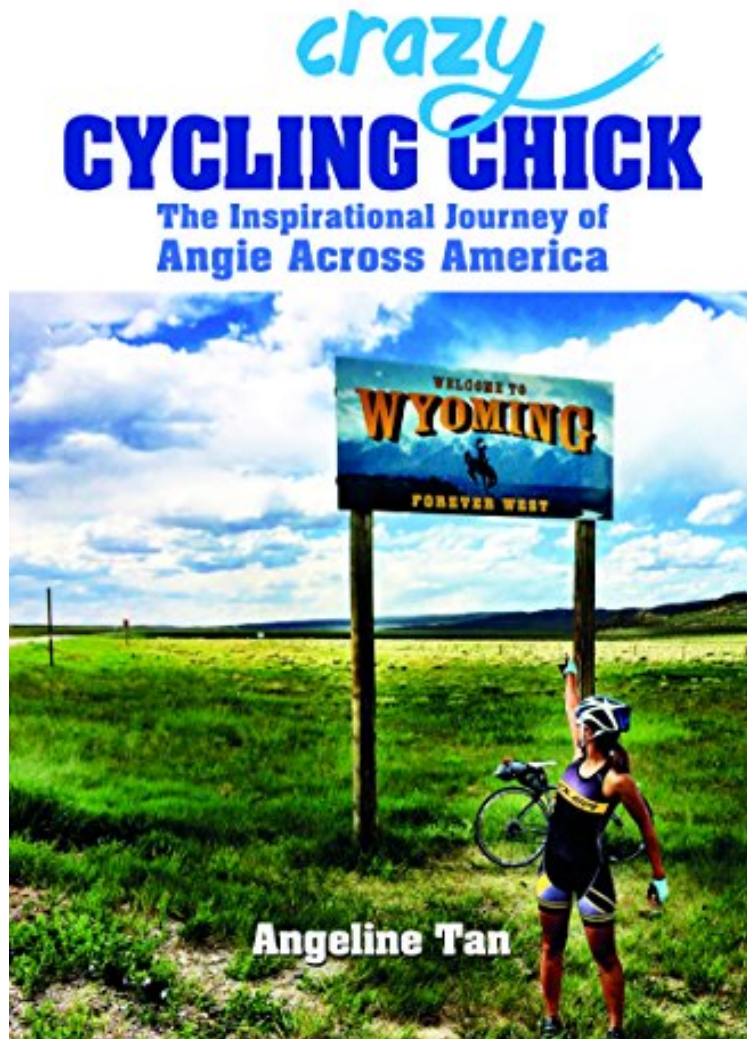

Chris S. Angeline Tan is an authentic gem and so is 'Crazy Cycling Chick'. You will not find a more authentic inspirational adventure. There is no manufacturing of words, tension, over the top grit, or crudeness. There is a beauty in reality. The journey is spelled out in the real, and it is an eye opening look at a courageous, faithful, person full of unabashed curiosity who has a wide eyed appreciation for the unique U.S. adventure she is on, all the while informed by a series of life experiences even further afield. The adventure is internal and external. I'd say it takes us 'behind the scenes', but there are no barriers from the get-go. Everything is laid bare. This seems to be out of respect for her reader and for the spiritual identity of her life as a part of something larger than herself. We have the privilege of seeing it unfold unflinchingly. I know what it's like to ride over a hundred miles day in and day out and can guarantee you she had very little time to visit with anyone other than a cafe or restaurant and a bed to go to sleep.
