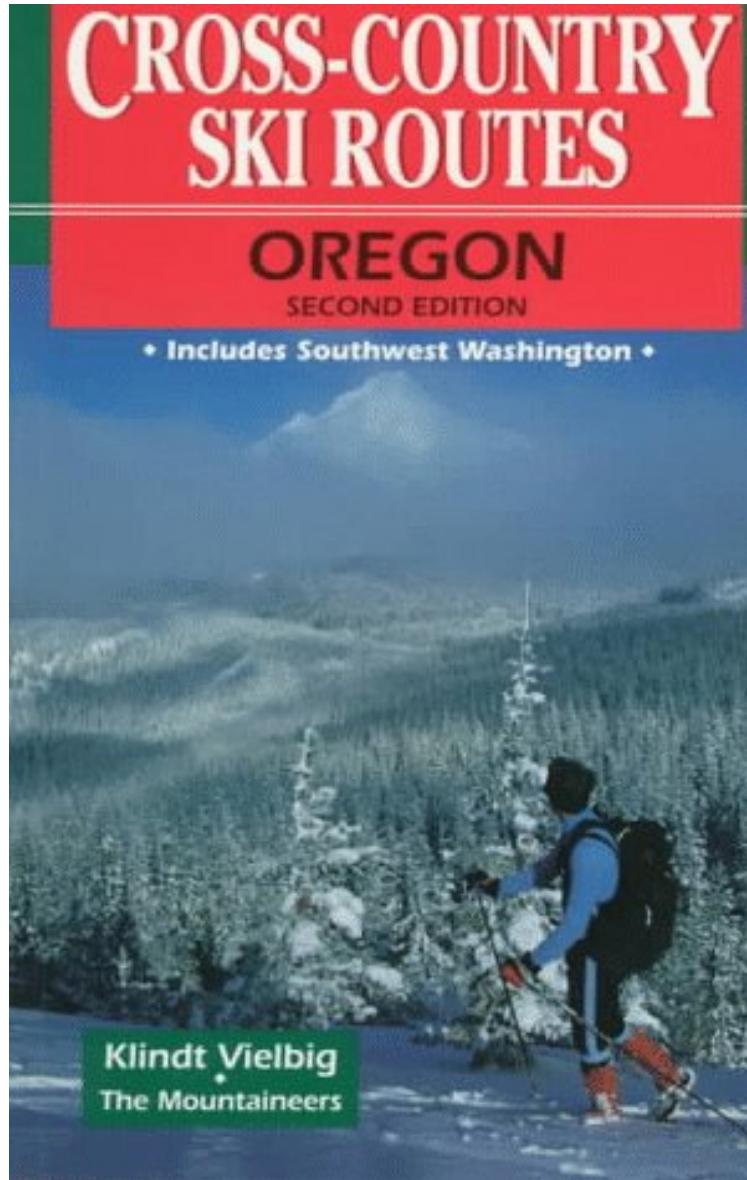

Fortunately, not much changes over time when it comes to XC trails so armed with this book, a good topo map (for the harder trails) and an adventurous spirit you will be able to explore a lot of remote ski trails in the state (plus ones suited for beginners wanting to grow). In fact this edition is quite old - one area that he described as a 'clearcut with wonderful views' was actually a dense young forest when I went through it last year.
