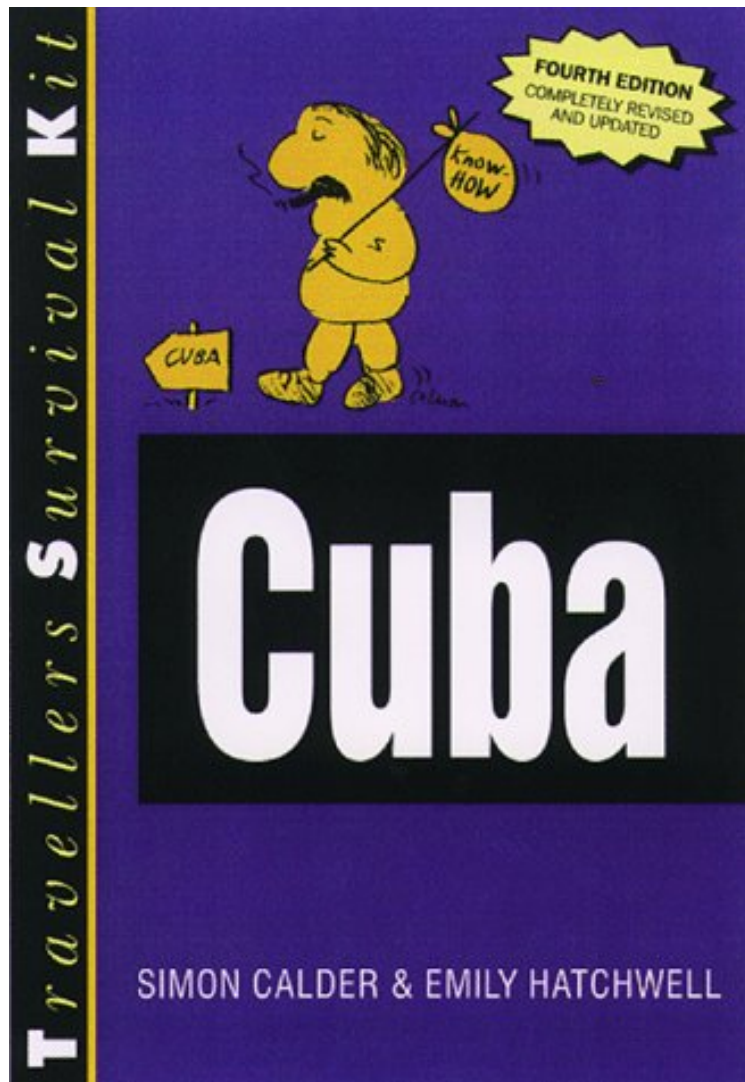

For example, it lists two phone numbers for a hotel in Vinales -- not only are the numbers wrong, but you have to make reservations through the central office in Havana, anyway. It's full of annoying mistakes like that. If you have your heart set on buying this, make sure you bring another guidebook (e.g. Baker) for backup.

This is a guide for travellers visiting Cuba, giving information on beaches, bars, music, money, restaurants and railways. The book also includes details of the cheapest and best ways to reach Cuba, avoiding crooks and con-men, booking the best-value hotels, renting bicycles and finding free health-care.
