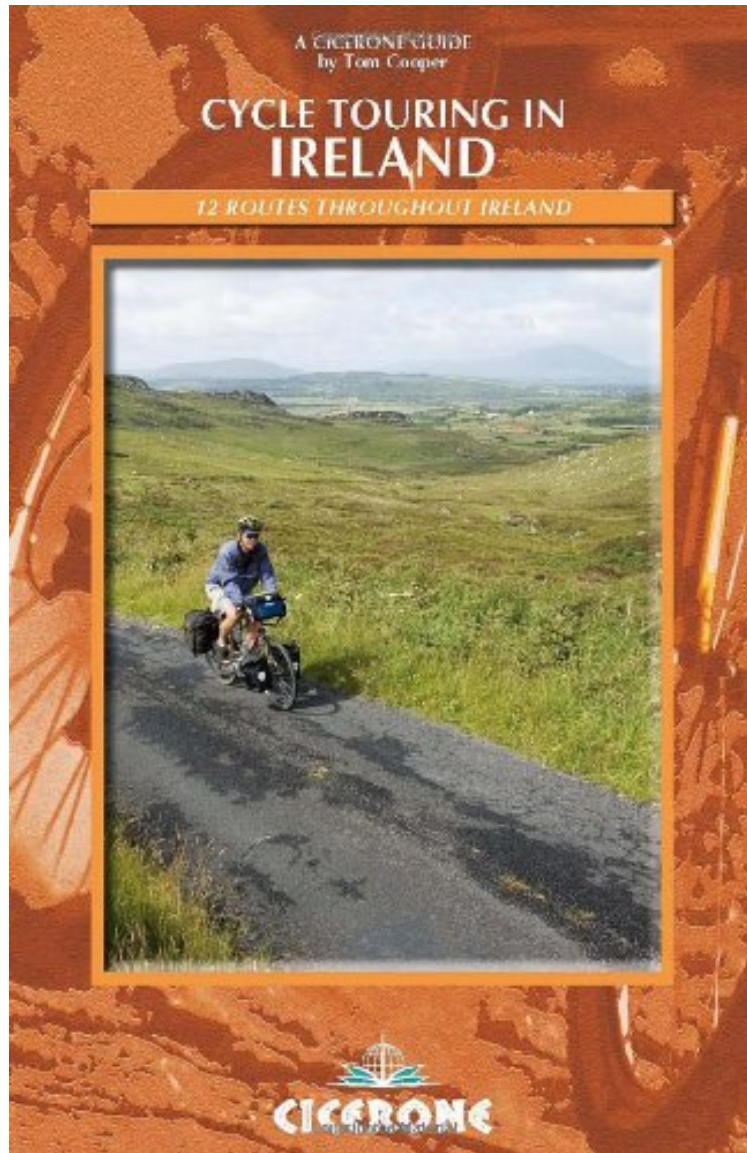

I develop all my routes on a GPS cycling website and then download the route to my Garmin Edge 1000 for navigation (turn by turn).
