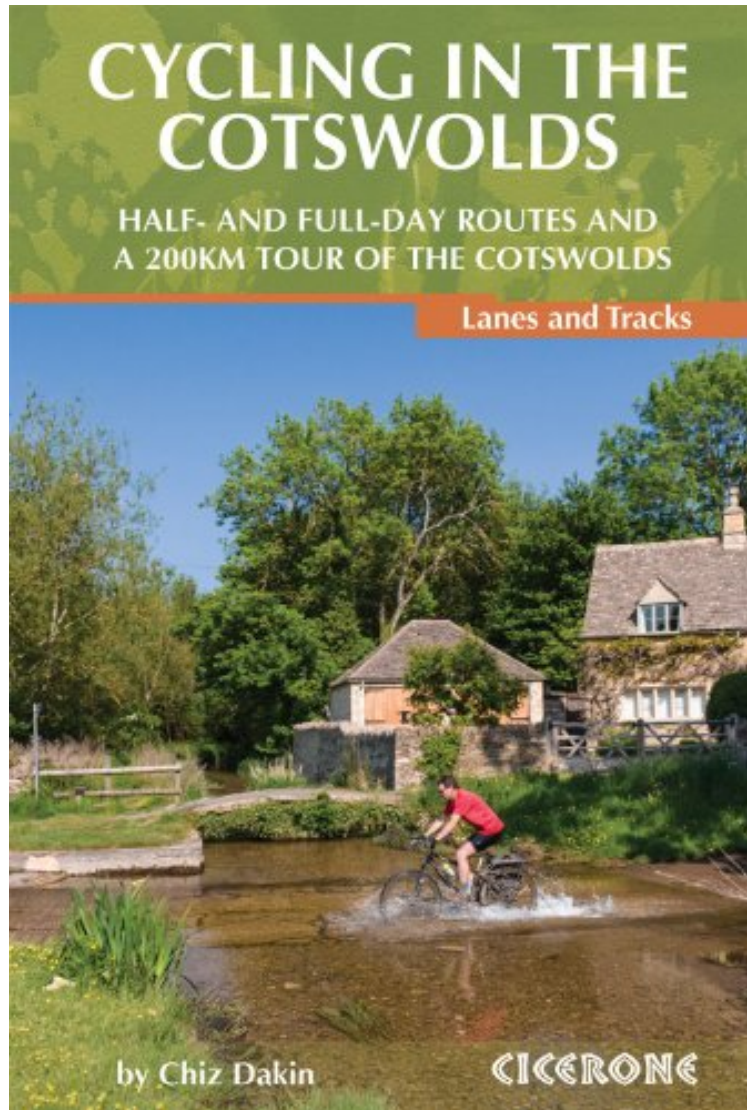

It boasts a network of quiet lanes, cycle-friendly canal paths and bridleways, as well as gentle riding on its southern and eastern rolling hills, while the scarp slope on its western side gives short but steep hill challenges. The guide's routes are graded from moderate to challenging, and each gives information on surface, distance and ascent as well as those all-important en route cafs and pubs. With detailed lists of recommended gear and local cycle shops, as well as comprehensive details on repair, first aid and pre-ride checks, this is your ideal guide to experiencing the best of the Cotswolds by bike.
