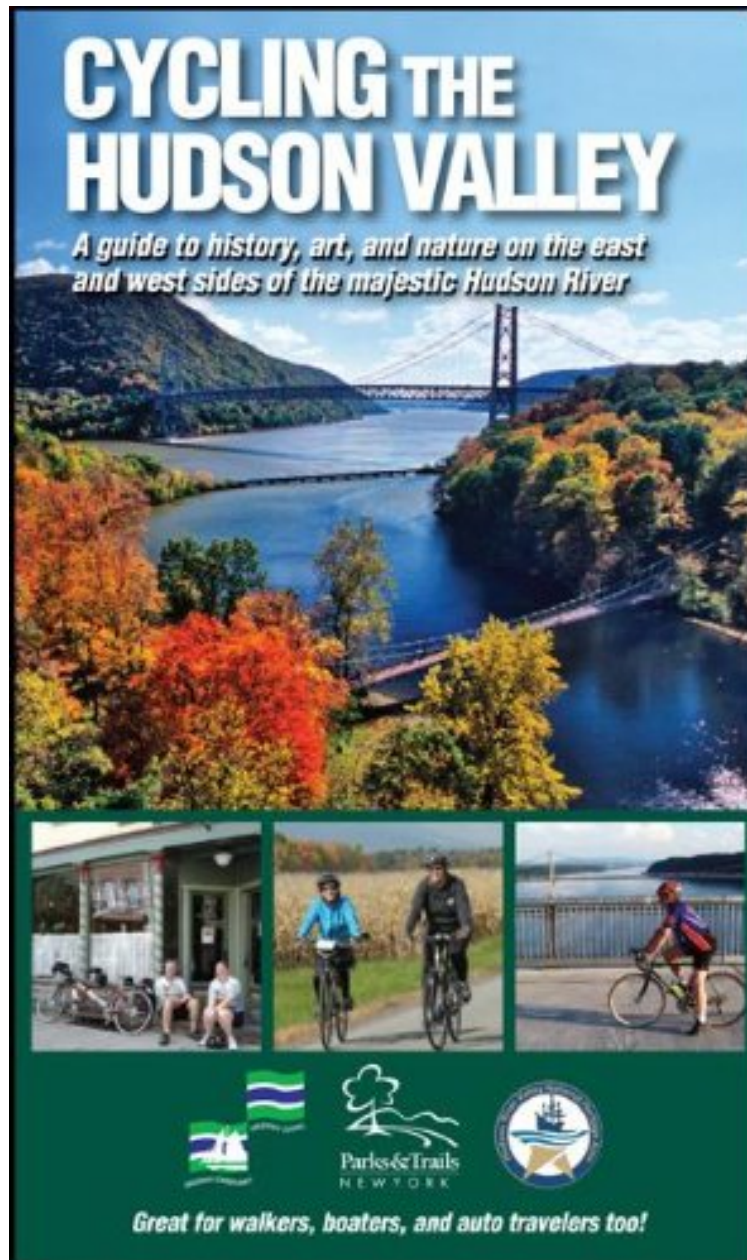

JacobsenThis is a strange bicycling guide. Guides usually give routes. This one just shows maps of regions, and points of interest. E.g. page 107, it's just a map, with roads, highways and such. Where does one bike here? The "Route and Travel Notes" lists 3 points of interest, and one cycling tip, which is to take one road to one point -- other "guides" don't even have a single cycling tip. So if you want fairly detailed maps of regions with historical sites -- this is the book for you. If you want suggested routes, with say turn-by-turn instructions, this really isn't the book for you.
