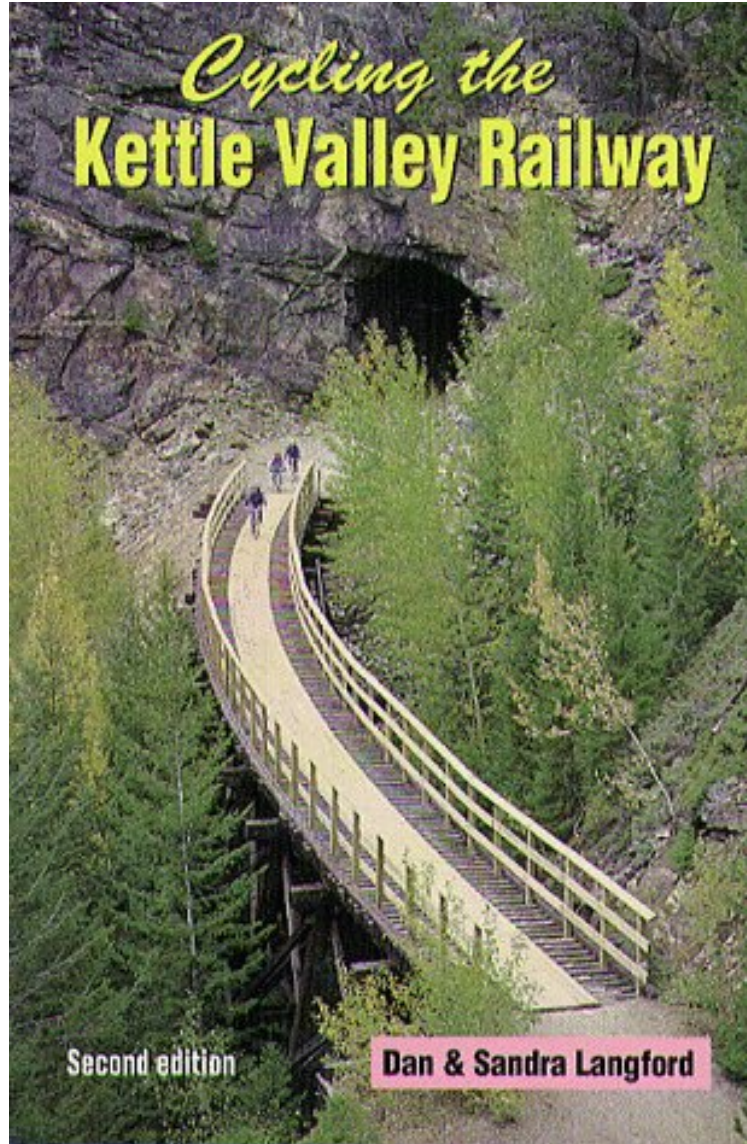

This edition includes the popular Columbia and Western Railway that runs from Castlegar to Midway.
