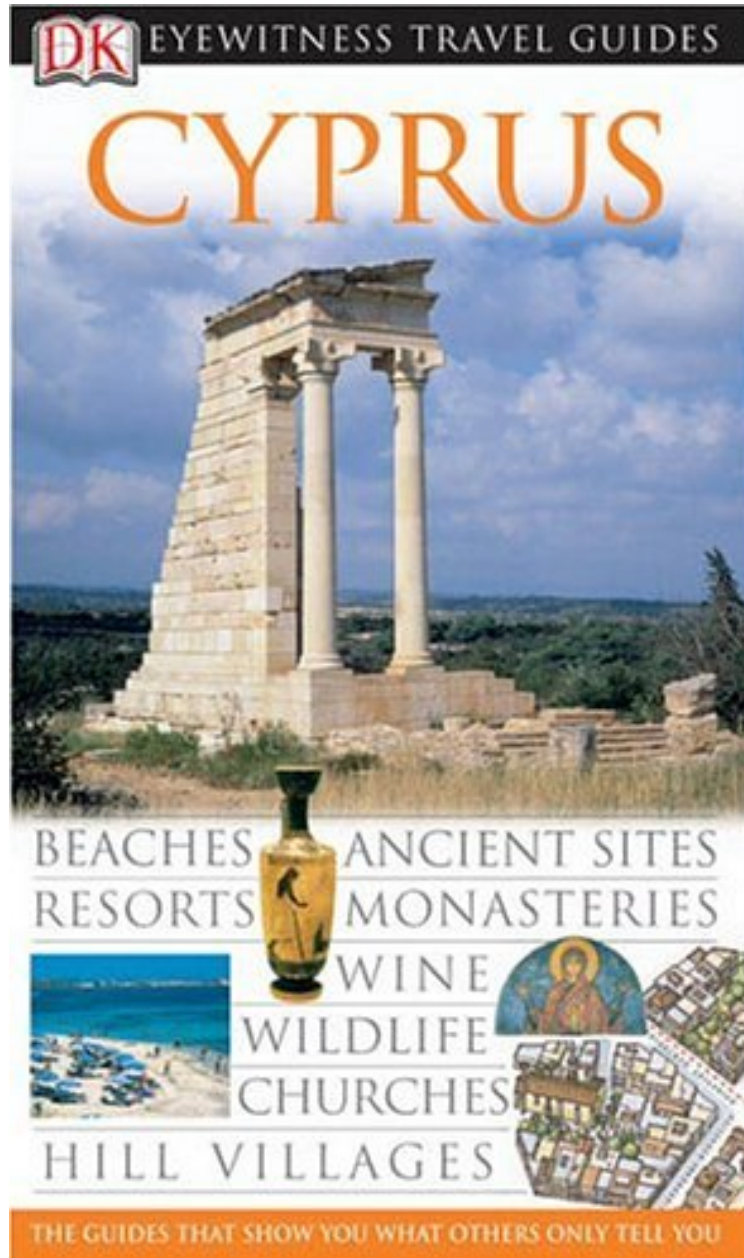

There is excellent information on line about the South, but the book was absolutely necessary for the North. It is light weight and tells about the sites. We used the internet to confirm times in the South and found some of the times for the North that way. In the south we used GPS but it doesn't yet exist for the north. This book had helpful information that with the maps provided by the TRNC tourism information booths, made it relatively easy to find our way around--remember the days before GPS and internet.
