The author of "Deltas and Estuaries of Colombia", Juan Manuel Diaz Merlano, a biologist, is a graduate of the University of the Andes in Bogota. He earned his Doctorate in Natural Sciences at the University of Giessen, Germany, with a dissertation on the Colombian Caribbean mollusks. He has been a university teacher and researcher in related marine biology and ecology fields. He was program coordinator for the Marine Biodiversity and Ecosystem Institute of Marine and Coastal Research and program coordinator of Conservation Biology at the Institute of Biological Resources Research of Alexander von Humboldt. He was a consultant to The Nature Conservancy Ecoregional Plan for the Eastern Tropical Pacific. He currently serves as deputy director of the Alexander von Humboldt Institute. He has authored over 50 scientific publications and several books related to the biodiversity of Colombia, among which include "Mollusks of the Colombian Caribbean," "Coral Areas of Colombia", "Coral Island San Andres" "La Guajira, Colombia" and " Tropical Dry Forests of Colombia". In 1994 he was awarded the National Prize of Marine Sciences of the Colombian Commission of Oceanography for his work on coral reefs of the island of San Andres. This book was commissioned by the Banco de Occidente with the assistance of the Colombian Ministry of the Environment and the National Park System of Columbia. Only 34,000 copies were printed. Book is in Spanish.
