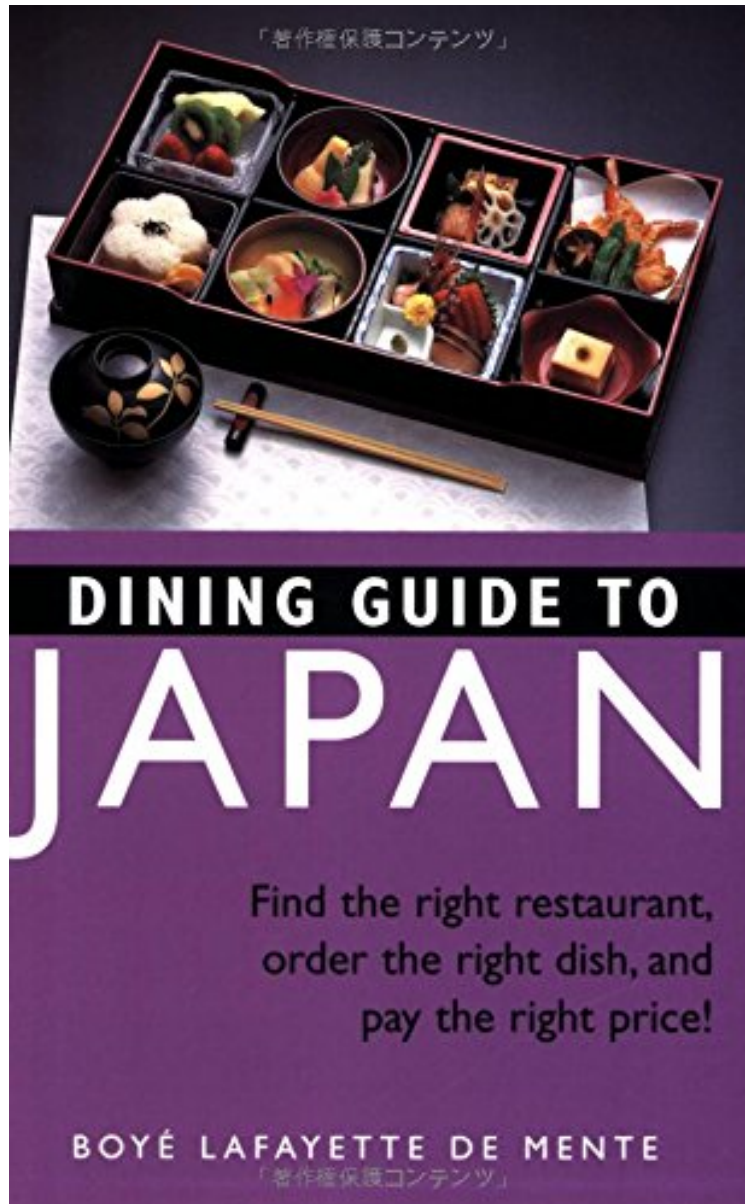

The food descriptions are excellent and very useful as a guide to what you can get, however the book is a big let-down when it comes to where you can get certain things. The vast majority of restaurants listed are in Tokyo; as if all of Japan was Tokyo, so unless you are strictly going to be in that area use the book only as a general guide. The listing of menu items in the back is very helpful but you will have to rely on another source of information to find places that serve what you are looking to eat outside the Tokyo area.
