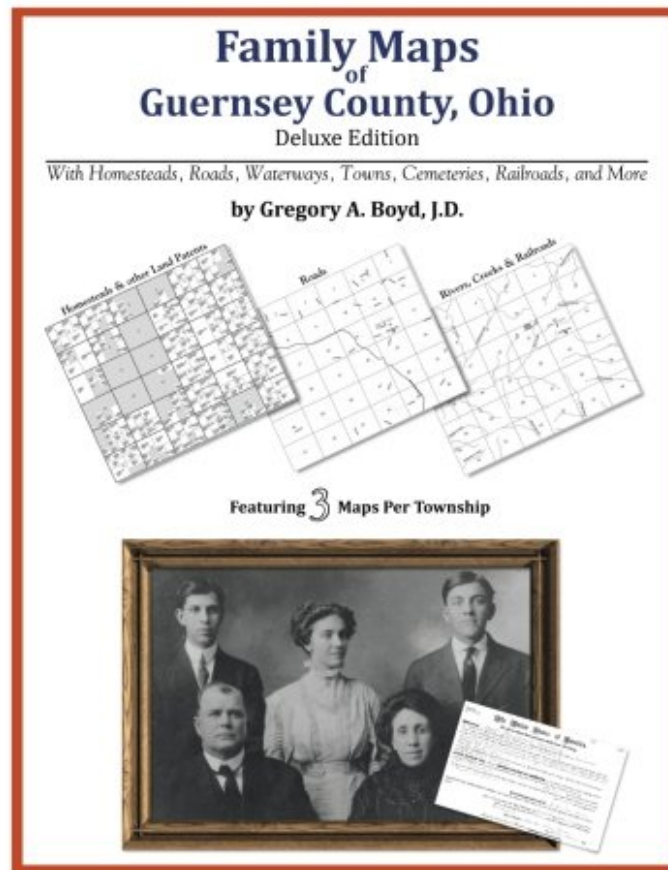

Having already done work on locating early patents (actually saw THE original for one party, now in the papers of the current property owner), and property locations in gazetteers atlases, I looked forward to some similar maps or reproductions, along with expanded information on other families. Have personally visited this county and explored back roads numerous times. Alas, the ancestor I had personally documented - complete with digitized patent - was nowhere to be found. I wrote the publishers, who said the government site had not yet posted the type of patent they purchased, though the sale first tax record is dated 1819. Assuming they answered my query accurately, I would recommend that they complete the early patent survey and provide amended information with the book - even

This volume in the Family Maps series contains newly created maps of original landowners (patent maps) in what is now Guernsey County, Ohio, gleaned from the indexes of the U.S. Bureau of Land Management. But it offers much more than that. For each township in the county, there are two additional maps accompanying the patent map: a road map and a map showing waterways, railroads, and both modern and many historical city-centers and cemeteries. Included are indexes to help you locate what you are looking for, whether you know a person's name, a last name, a place-name, or a cemetery. The combination of maps and indexes are designed to aid researchers of American history or genealogy to explore frontier neighborhoods, examine family migrations, locate hard-to-find cemeteries and towns, as well as locate land based on legal descriptions found in old documents or deeds. The patent-maps are essentially plat maps but instead of depicting owners for a particular year, these maps show original landowners, no matter when the transfer from the federal government was completed. Dates of patents typically begin near the time of statehood and run into the early 1900s.
