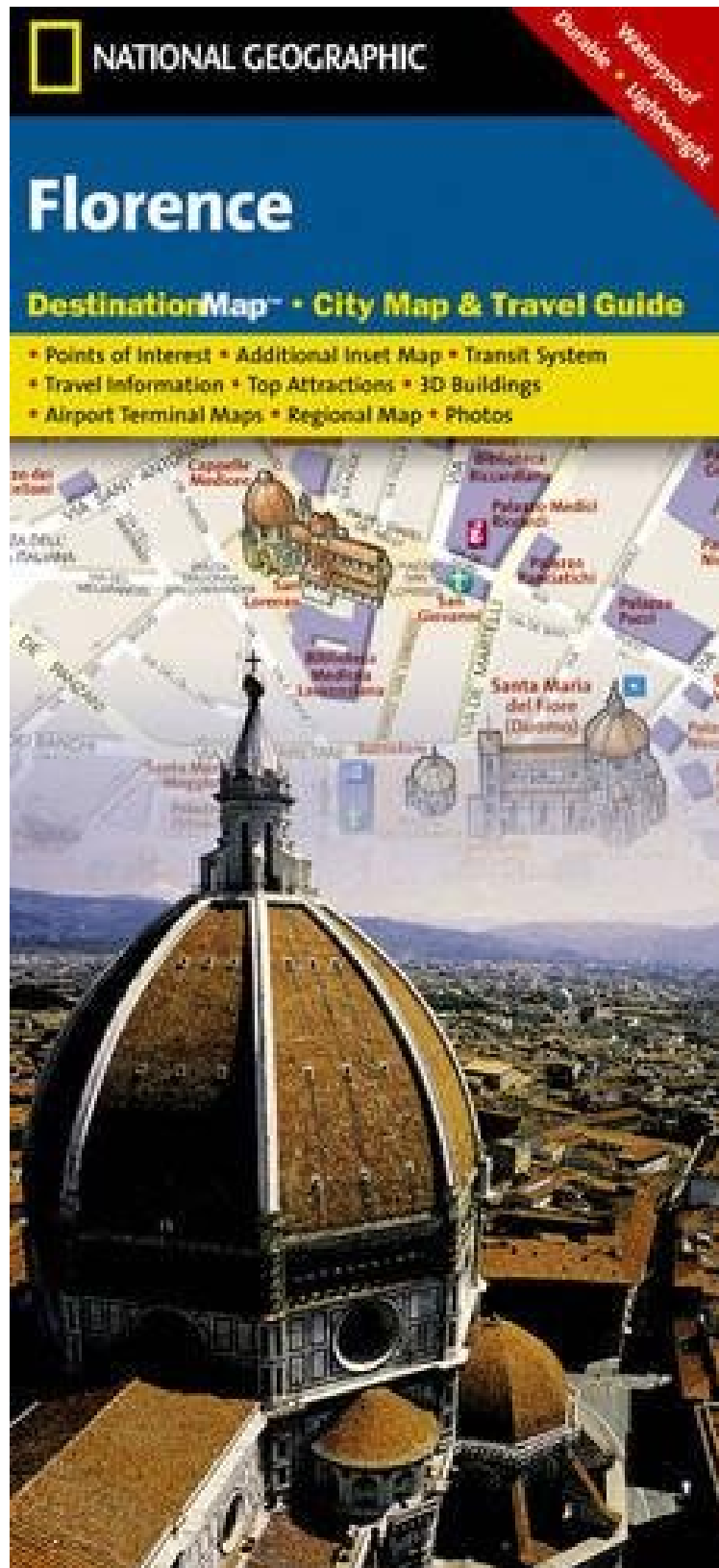

It's not ultra compact, but it's flexible enough to fold to just the section you want, which is valuable if you're walking around in an unfamiliar city. Its advantage over other maps I have: The small streets are readable compared to the tiny type of my AAA Spiral Guide of Florence, my Streetwise Rome map has similar tiny type and I find the accordion style annoying, and my MapEasy Guidemap to Rome leaves off some small streets and gets too "chatty" in noting landmarks.
