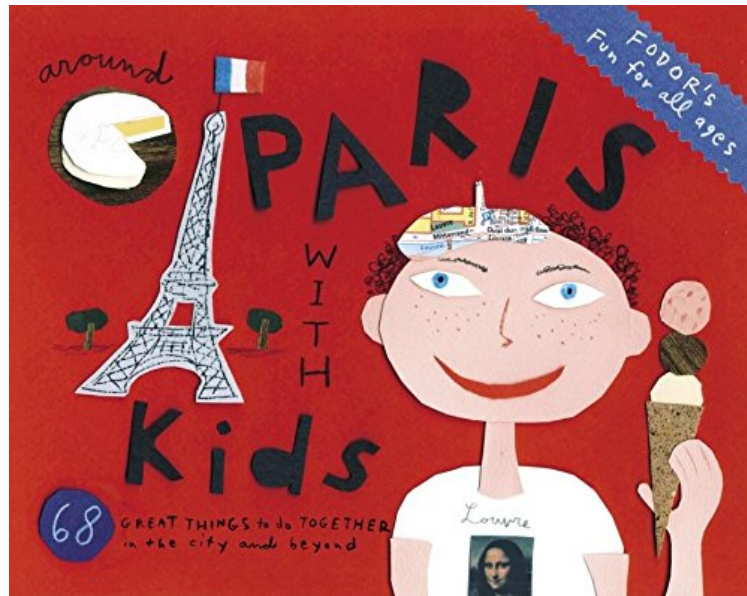

The book is terribly organized and, for someone like us who is new to the city, it doesn't help at all with deciding what would be best to do during our time there.The headlines at the top of each page are in French so if you are not fluent enough to understand them, you are forced to read through each page to decide if it would be something the family might enjoy.
