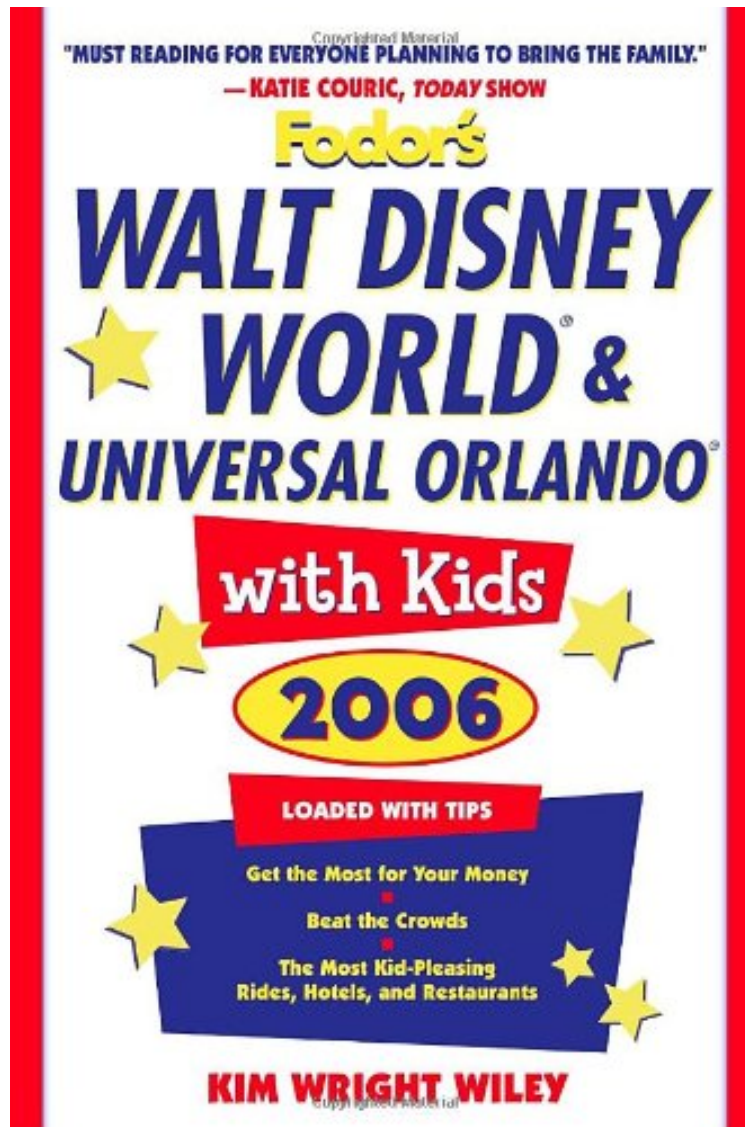

However, if you want to know what is missing from this book and you're the sort that craves detailed info, get the Unofficial Guide to WDW (not the For Kids version). It is a fun read, but much longer. It has kid oriented info, plus much more.
