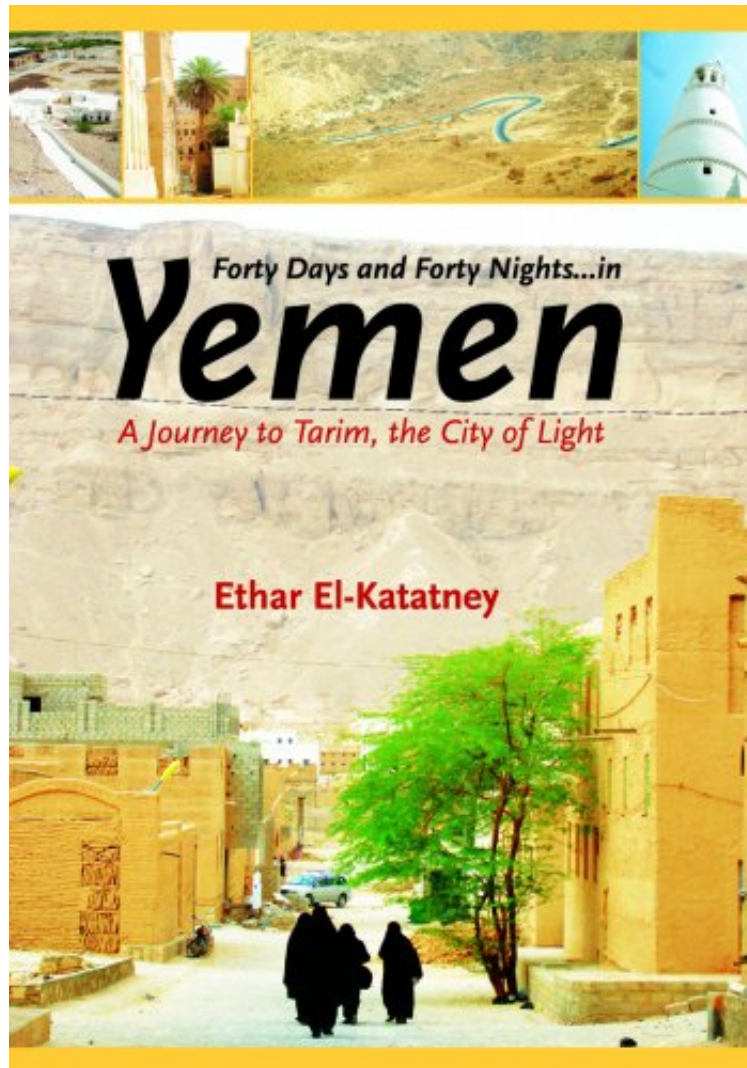


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Forty Days and Forty Nights - in Yemen: A Journey to Tarim, the City of Light
