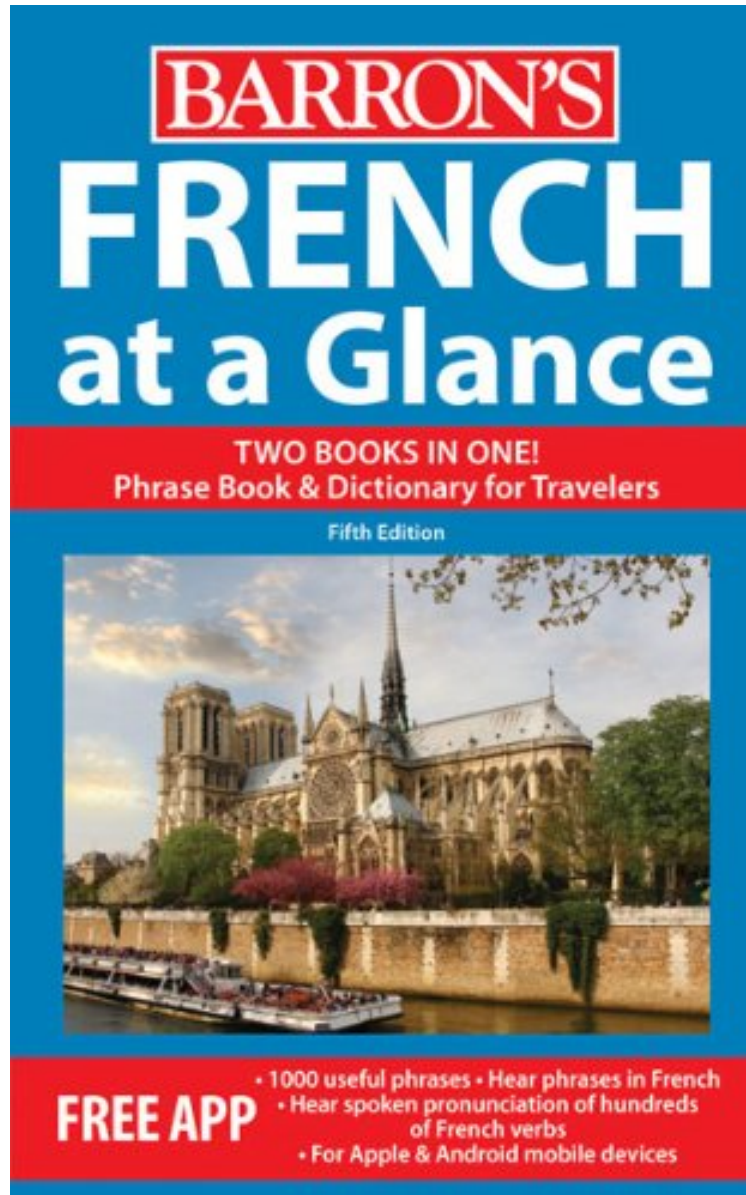

Either is equally useful to look up a word or phrase, so buy the older edition, which is much cheaper. However, if you want to try to read local newspapers or otherwise learn the culture, the vocabulary in "French at a Glance" is much too limited. You need to carry a pocket dictionary. I especially like the Larousse, which is fully bilingual with 80 thousand translations.
