I spent a month in Buenos Aires in early 2011 and had a delightful time in this beautiful city. I found Frommer's guide quite good overall. However, in finding restaurants, I'd suggest that you use guiaoleo.com which has over 100,000 reviews of Buenos Aires restaurants, almost all of which are by locals. It's all in Spanish, so if that's a problem, you can always use Google Translate. Restaurants are listed by types and neighborhoods, and you can do a variety of searches.
