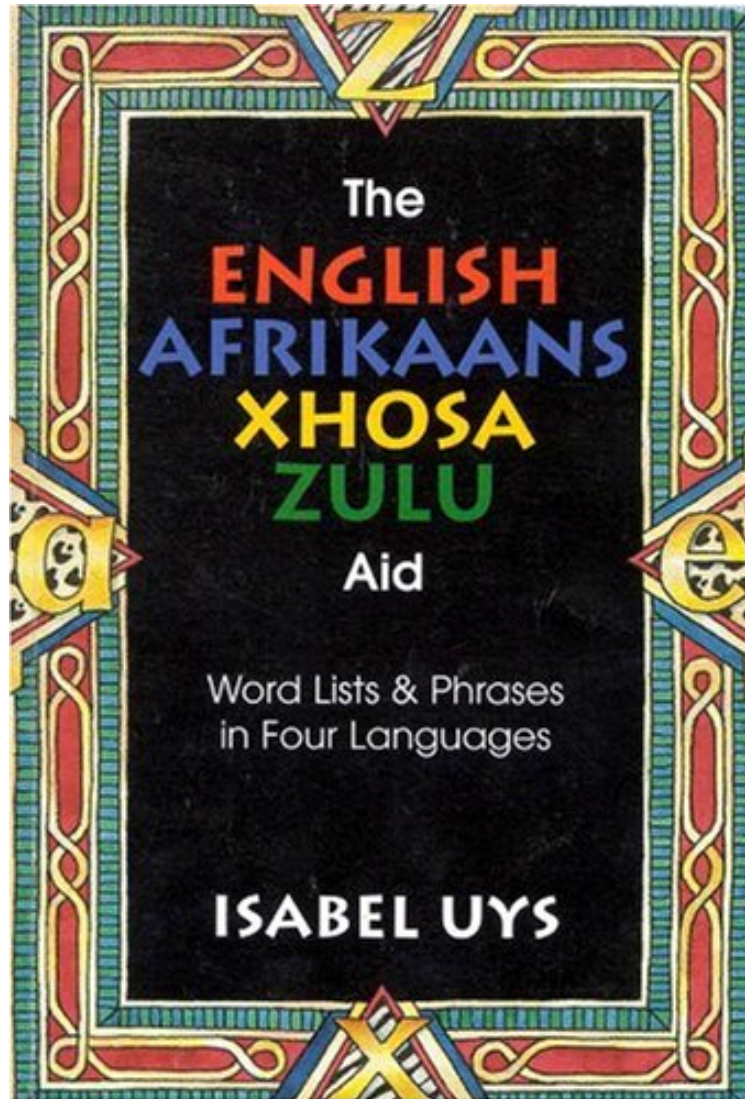

However, Zulu and Xhosa are extremely difficult to pronounce (clicks and tones) and to get it right this product really needs to be accompanied by audio CDs.
