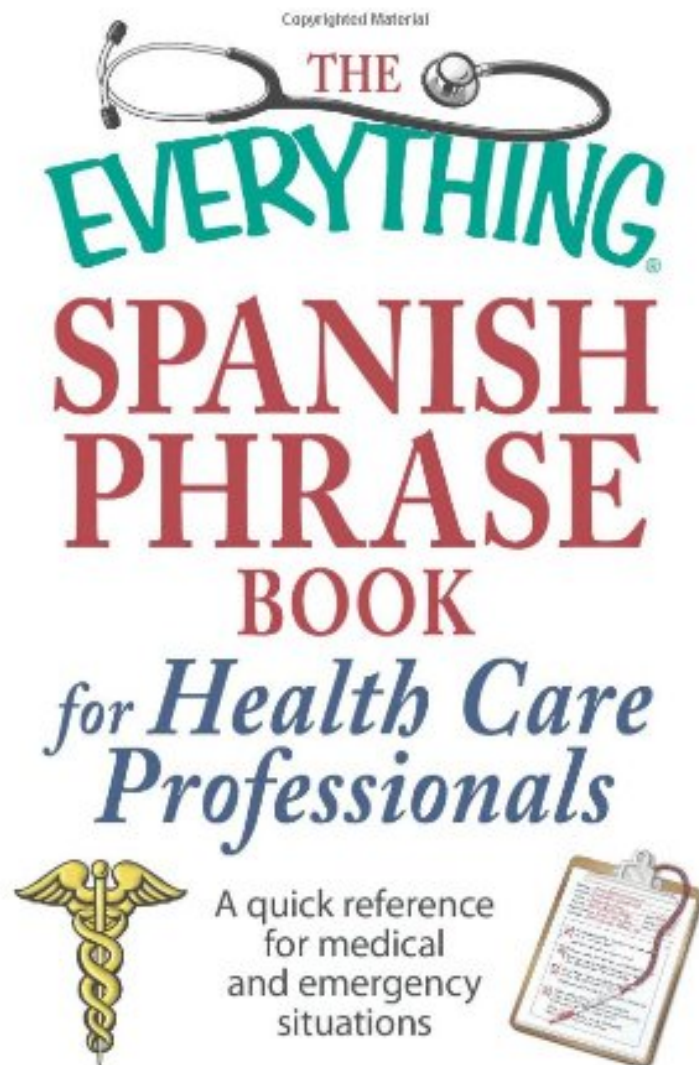

I already speak some Spanish, but I need to learn more medically relevant Spanish. That is what the book is supposed to help with. The book is interesting, and it progresses through various medical scenarios while building vocabulary and a bit of grammar. The canned phrases are well planned and seem potentially useful. So far, so good. Unfortunately, the book is seriously flawed in other ways. It badly needs careful proof reading/copy editing. It is replete with spelling errors and has at least some mistakes regarding Spanish language itself, not to mention an occasional English grammatical error. A lot of the content is really good, so I don't think I should give it just 1 star. I think I know enough Spanish to catch most of the errors so I believe it will be useful but I don't think I could recommend purchasing it.
