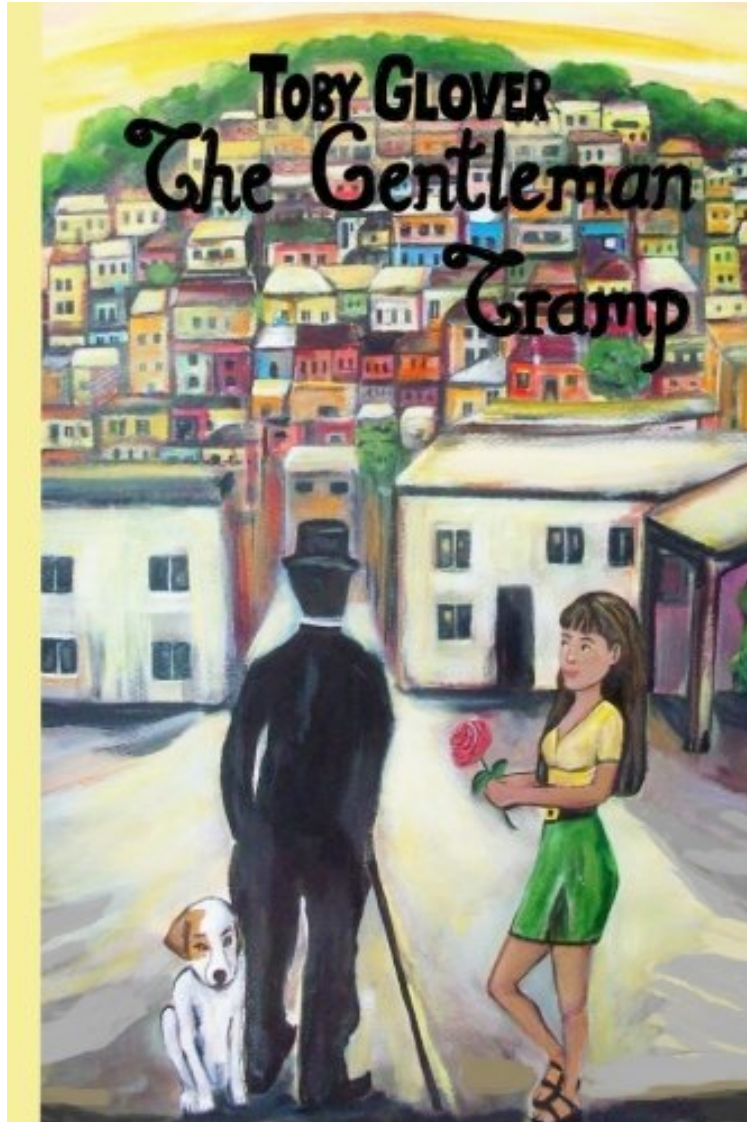

The voice of the book is an interesting combination of British English thought and various cultural flair depending on the main characters surroundings. The main character, a homeless Charlie Chaplain impersonator and an outsider to these various cultures, can most closely be described as a Peter Pan

character. His constant inner dialogue with himself is unique and strangely child-like: the boy who never grew up. He along with his morbidly funny dog and proverbial albatross, Scraps, travel the world looking for gigs, adventures and a way out of bad experiences. He is also strangely connected and disconnected throughout the novel both outside of society and impersonating a member of society. Through the main characters cynicism, the reader learns about Mariana, the first great love of the main characters, Bruce, the overly successful and glamorously vagrant brother and other backstage characters that the main character ultimately distances himself from for one reason or another. Very quickly, you learn that there is something seriously wrong with the main character some sort of mental isolation accompanied by physical seizures and other ailments. I won't give away much of the rest of the novel, but the tone of voice, the symbolism, the rhythm of the text and the story of isolation of the Gentleman Tramp is simply gripping. I could not stop reading this piece. I was enthralled with the voice of the main character and the delicate and often betrayed relationship he has with Scraps. The Gentleman Tramp is both extremely intelligent in his cynicism and developmentally stunted in his emotions and perceptions of reality. He stops talking at an early age and becomes silent while only writing words down for a form of communication just like his favorite screen star, Charlie Chaplin. His disappointing high school years while being bullied and unfriended have plagued him with grief along with the medical condition Epilepsy. With high school finished the Gentleman Tramp continues living in his parents home and attends college. He is elated that his high school years are over and college has begun but his main focus is the campus library, not his courses. He stops to dine at his favorite charming local caf where immediately his eyes gaze on a brand new waitress. He can't stop staring at her as she stands beside his table. He becomes consumed with Mariana's dark rich hair, gorgeous legs and Rio de Janeiro accent. His inner and outer being become self-indulged while staring at her but knows that a gentleman should never stare because it is impolite. The Gentleman Tramp leaves in haste fully before Mariana has a chance to come back to the table and ask for his order. His nervousness kicks in becoming clumsy while knocking over a nearby chair. He feels true emotions in the moment. It had been years since he'd felt any kind of emotional response to any type of situation until Mariana came along. He falls in love.
