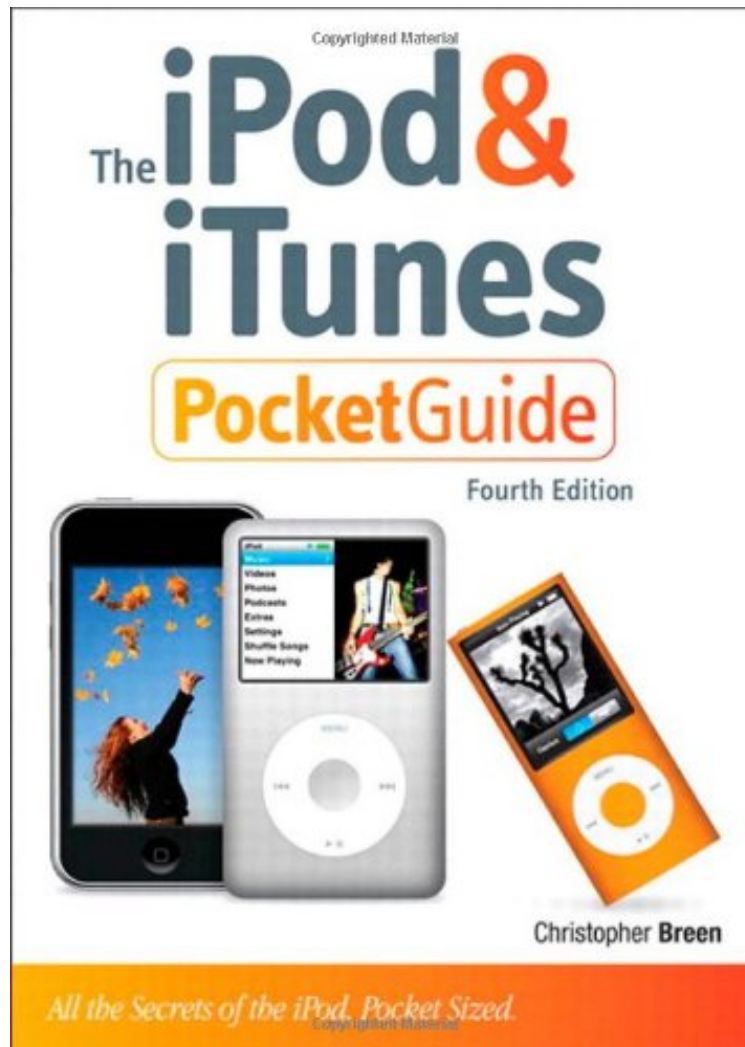

A large portion of pages are devoted to the iPod Touch because this model has many more functions and features compared to the traditional iPods. There is also good coverage of the iTunes Store, and a chapter on the iTunes Wi-Fi and Apps Stores. The last chapter is on usage tips and troubleshooting. This book is the most recently (Jan 6, 2009) published book on iPod and iTunes available in Kindle edition. Having this in my iPod Touch means that I can always look up something about iPod/iTunes or simply browse around (and leave the physical book at home). The cost of this Kindle edition is also lower than the paperback version. For only \$6.39, this is a very good deal!
